Thomas Buchanan MLA has asked

The Minister for Communities for an update on the Northern Ireland Community Infrastructure Fund.

Answer

I can advise that 752 of the 835 applicants who submitted an Expression of Interest have now been invited to complete a Stage Two application to the Northern Ireland Community Infrastructure Fund.

The closing date for applicants to submit their Stage Two application was Friday 23 January 2026 with 521 applications received.

Scoring and assessment of submitted applications is now underway, and it is currently planned that applicants will be notified of their outcomes by the end of March 2026.

Funded projects will then be delivered within the 2026/27 financial year.

Due to the high level of interest in the Fund and the clear need for intervention within the sector, I am keen to see this pilot scheme become a longer term programme and have instructed my officials to bring forward proposals.
