AQW 45266 22-27 – Annex A

This issue is an operational matter for Northern Ireland Housing Executive, they have advised me as follows:

“The Northern Ireland Housing Executive (NHE) will undertake works to address defects in external areas within its estates, including resurfacing where deemed necessary following identification of a potential hazard. However, the NIHE’s current Housing Management System (HMS) does not record maintenance activity at a level of detail that allows works to be categorised by specific asset type, such as footpaths.

While records are held of response maintenance works completed within NIHE estates, these are generally captured under broader categories of external or communal maintenance. As such, it is not possible to provide a verified breakdown solely identifying footpath resurfacing works.

The information within the table below is representative of response maintenance works undertaken in areas outside the curtilage of individual properties relevant to resurfacing. These works may include works to footpaths, but also encompasses other shared or communal assets, such as alleyways, car parks, communal hard standings, and shared areas within blocks of flats. These works are not recorded in a way that allows them to be disaggregated specifically to footpaths.
