

1. INTRODUCTION

This reading list – 'Brexit Outcomes and Northern Ireland' – is intended to assist Members of the Legislative Assembly (MLAs) and others to contemplate developments following the UK's formal exit from the EU on 31 January 2020. For political, economic, geographic and social reasons, the impacts on Northern Ireland of UK withdrawal from the EU might be expected to differ in important ways from the impact of withdrawal on other parts of the UK. Most obviously, Northern Ireland is unique in that it is the only part of the UK which has a land border with an EU Member State.

Since the February edition, several significant political developments have taken place. With the formation of the Northern Ireland Executive and the return to normal Assembly business, the Windsor Framework Democratic Scrutiny Committee formally came into being. More broadly, the UK general election has led to the formation of a new government and the potential for a shift in relations towards the European Union.

When compiling this reading list, an attempt has been made to select commentary, analysis and media coverage which has particular relevance to the specific context of Northern Ireland. The list also includes strategically important documents, such as the published positions of the UK and Irish governments and the EU institutions.

As the volume of published material on Brexit is vast and varied, this reading list does not purport to be a single comprehensive source covering all issues and opinions. However, the material has been drawn from a wide range of well-established and authoritative sources and RalSe intends to update the reading list as appropriate.

In addition to this reading list, RalSe maintains an EU Exit Hub with information on the Protocol, Windsor Framework, Common Frameworks and EU Exit Legislation.
