1. INTRODUCTION

This reading list – ‘Brexit Outcomes and Northern Ireland’ – has been prepared to assist Members of the Legislative Assembly (MLAs) and others in considering developments following the United Kingdom’s withdrawal from the European Union on 31 January 2020.

The publication of this updated edition coincides with a period of continued reflection and change. June 2026 marks ten years since the 2016 referendum on EU membership, a milestone that has prompted reassessment across the UK and Ireland of Brexit’s longer-term political, economic and constitutional implications. In Northern Ireland, these considerations carry particular relevance given the region’s specific arrangements under the Withdrawal Agreement and the Windsor Framework, and ongoing discussion regarding their operation and effects.

Since the previous edition of this reading list in April 2026, there have also been developments in the wider political context. The recent resignation of Sir Keir Starmer as Leader of the Labour Party has introduced a degree of uncertainty regarding the future direction of UK policy, including its approach to relations with the European Union. Changes in leadership may have implications for the implementation and development of post-Brexit arrangements, including those relating to the Windsor Framework, UK–EU cooperation, and regulatory alignment or divergence. These matters remain relevant to Northern Ireland’s institutions, economy and society.

Recent events have also drawn attention to issues relating to cross-border movement and security on the island of Ireland. In the context of the recent Belfast knife attack, some public and political commentary has referred to the operation of the Common Travel Area and travel arrangements between Northern Ireland and Ireland. The Common Travel Area continues to underpin the movement of British and Irish citizens. Discussion in this area has highlighted considerations around balancing security concerns with the maintenance of existing arrangements for cross-border mobility, within the broader framework of post-Brexit commitments.

At the same time, a number of established issues continue to inform discussion in Northern Ireland. These include arrangements governing the movement of goods between Great Britain and Northern Ireland, the application of aspects of EU law within the region, questions of democratic oversight, and the balance between Northern Ireland’s position within the UK

internal market and its access to the EU single market. The concept of “dual market access” continues to feature in policy and economic discussions, with differing perspectives on its implications.

In this context, marked both by the passage of time since the referendum and by more recent developments, this reading list brings together a selection of relevant commentary, analysis and source material. It focuses in particular on Northern Ireland, while also situating developments within the wider context of UK–EU relations. The list draws on a range of sources, including academic work, policy analysis, media reporting and official documentation, including material published by the UK and Irish Governments and EU institutions.

Given the breadth of material relating to Brexit outcomes, this reading list is not intended to be exhaustive. Rather, it provides a curated selection of resources to support informed consideration of key issues affecting Northern Ireland. RaISe will continue to review and update the list in light of further developments.
