# Housing: Net zero, decarbonisation and retrofitting

21 October 2024

#### 1 Introduction

The <u>Climate Change Act (Northern Ireland) 2022</u> sets ambitious targets for the reduction in net zero greenhouse gas emissions by 2050. The new <u>Housing Supply Strategy for Northern Ireland 2024-2039</u> recognises the key role that both the construction of new housing and the retrofitting of existing homes will play in helping reduce emissions. The Department for Communities' latest <u>Climate Change Action Plan 2024-25</u> sets out some of the areas the Department is working on towards meeting climate change commitments including the development of a Fuel Poverty Strategy, a Departmental Climate Change and Sustainability Strategy and a Residential Buildings Decarbonisation Strategy.

The Climate Change Committee report on <u>Northern Ireland's Fourth Carbon Budget</u> has advised that significant investment will be required in the residential buildings sector, primarily due to the upfront costs of low-carbon heating systems and energy efficiency improvements. Many recent reports, for example, by <u>Forum for Better Homes NI</u> and the <u>Chartered Institute of Housing NI</u>, explore both the challenges and opportunities in decarbonising the housing sector in Northern Ireland.

This topical digest provides a reading list of recent strategies, research reports, news articles and blog articles relating to residential decarbonisation and net zero.
