

Assembly Members (Inflationary increase to salary) (Period when there is no Executive) Determination (Northern Ireland) 2018

CONTENTS

1. Salary: no inflationary increase

Section 1 of the Northern Ireland Assembly Members (Pay) Act 2018 confers on the Secretary of State the function of making determinations, as to –

- (a) the salaries and allowances payable under section 47 of the Northern Ireland Act 1998 during a period when there is no Executive, and
- (b) the allowances and gratuities payable under section 48 of the Northern Ireland Act 1998 during a period when there is no Executive.

In exercise of this power, the Secretary of State makes the following Determination.

Salary: no inflationary increase

1. At the end of paragraph 3 of the Assembly Members (Salaries and Expenses) Determination (Northern Ireland) 2016 insert –

“(4) This paragraph does not apply during a period when there is no Executive.

(5) In this paragraph “period when there is no Executive” has the same meaning as in the Northern Ireland Assembly Members (Pay) Act 2018.”.

Interpretation, commencement and title

2. (1) The Interpretation Act (Northern Ireland) 1954 applies to this Determination as it applies to an Act of the Northern Ireland Assembly.

(2) This Determination comes into operation on 1 April 2018.

(3) This Determination may be cited as the Assembly Members (Inflationary increase to salary) (Period when there is no Executive) Determination (Northern Ireland) 2018.
